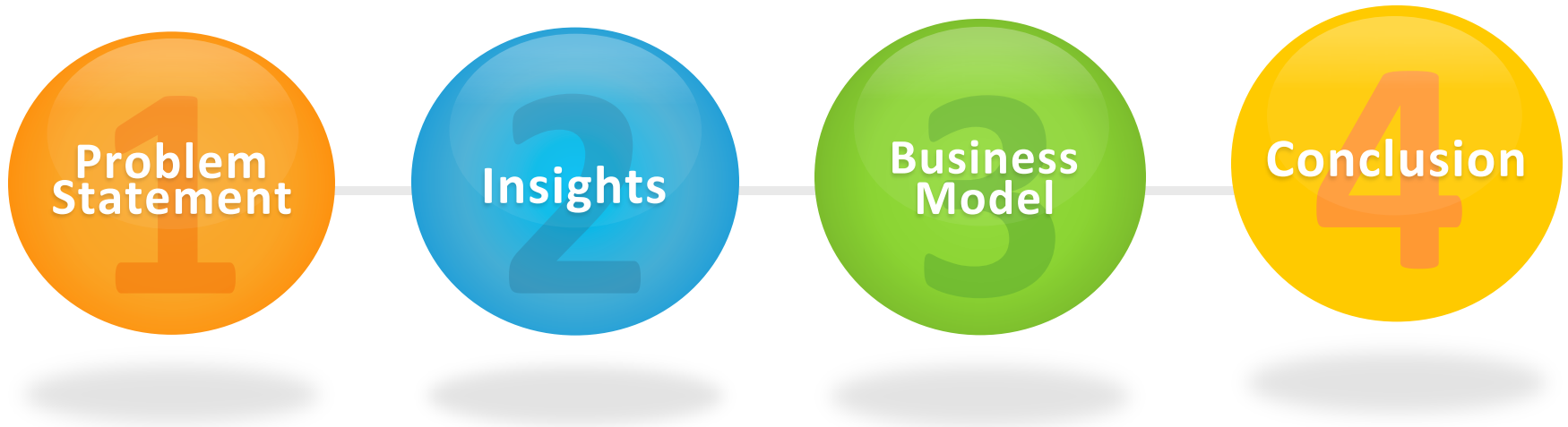

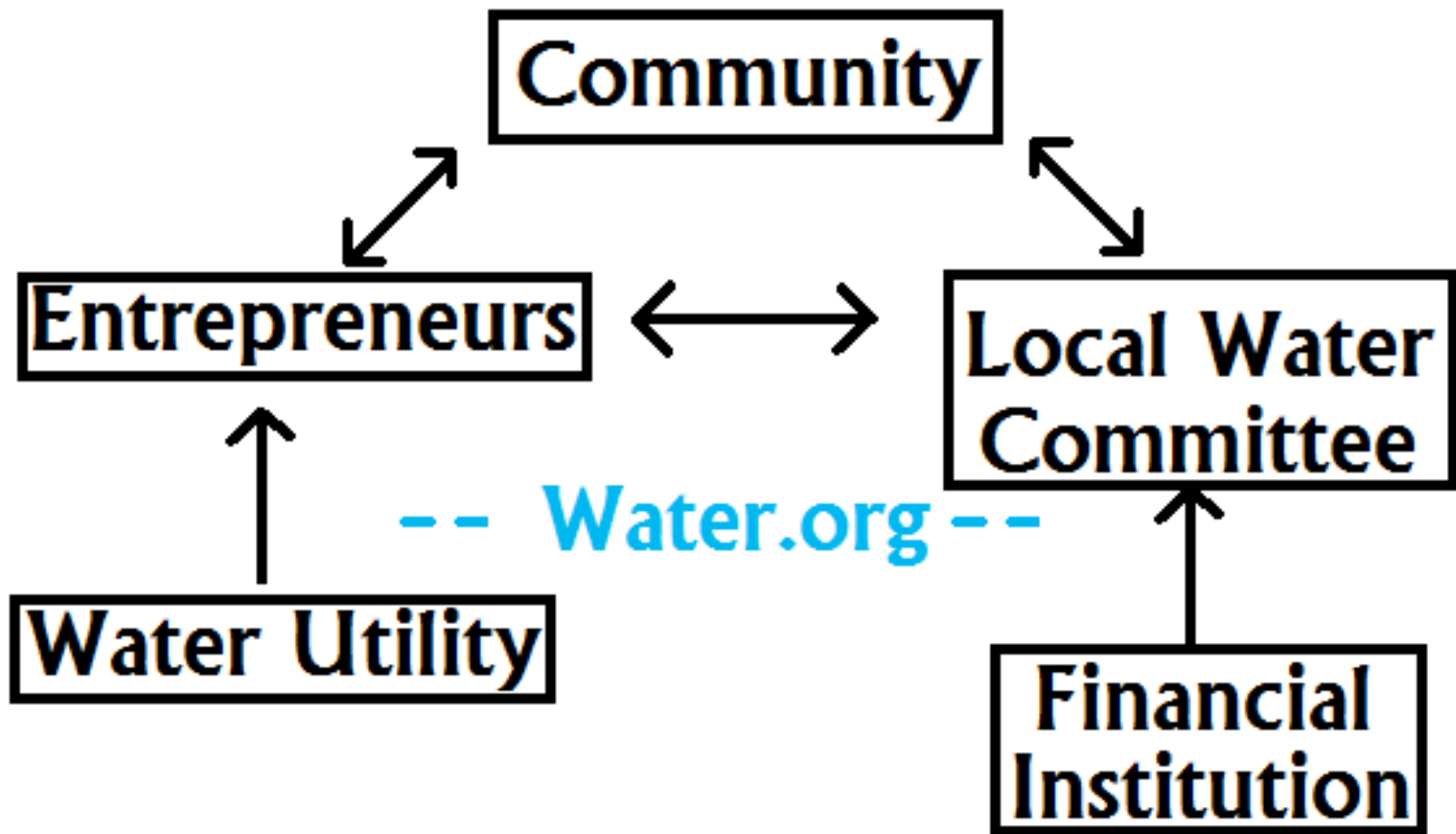
Problem Statement

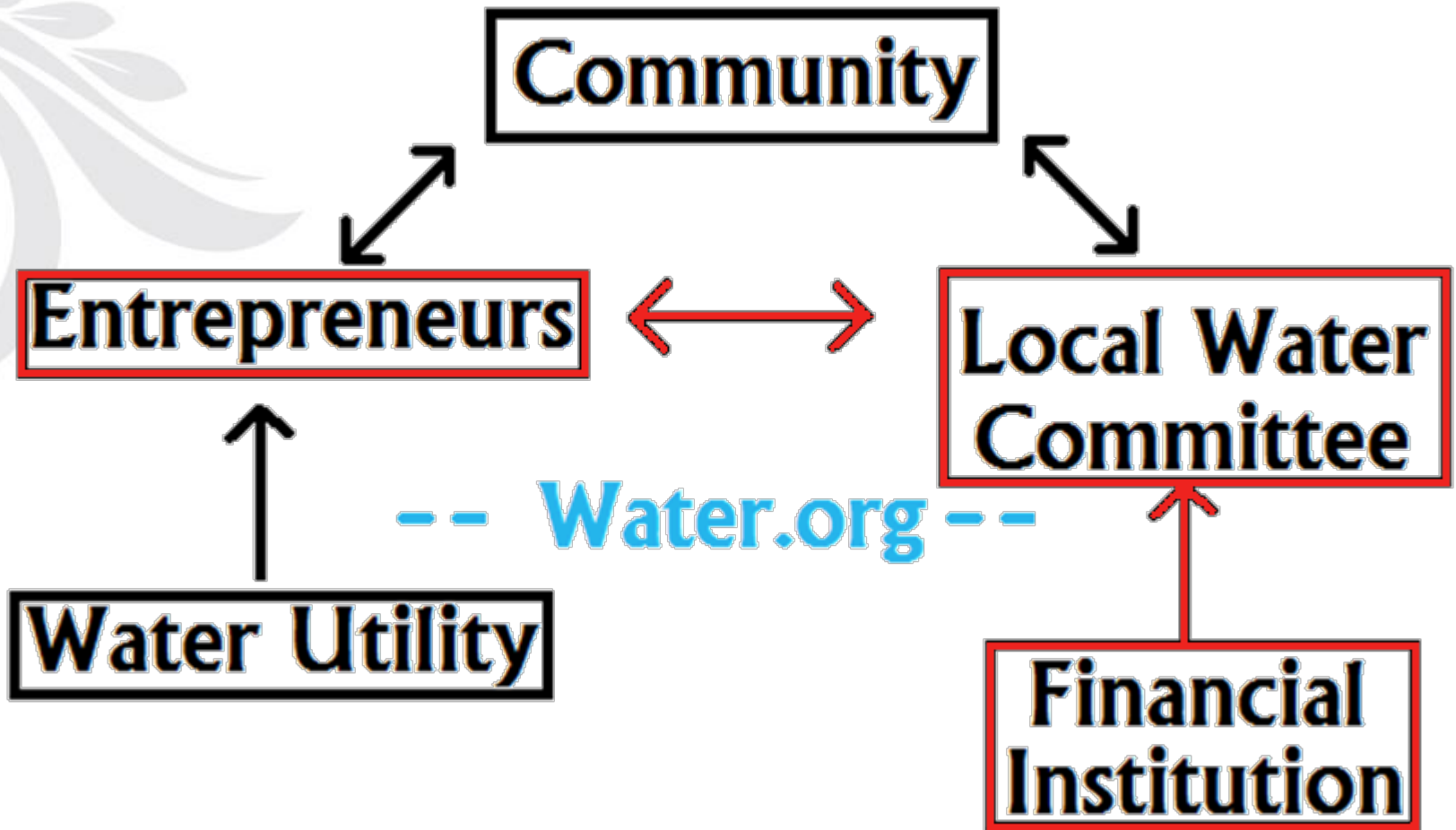
How do we develop a sustainable and scalable model that will provide 100 million individuals with access to clean drinking water and sanitation facility.

4. Changing local mindsets is key to success

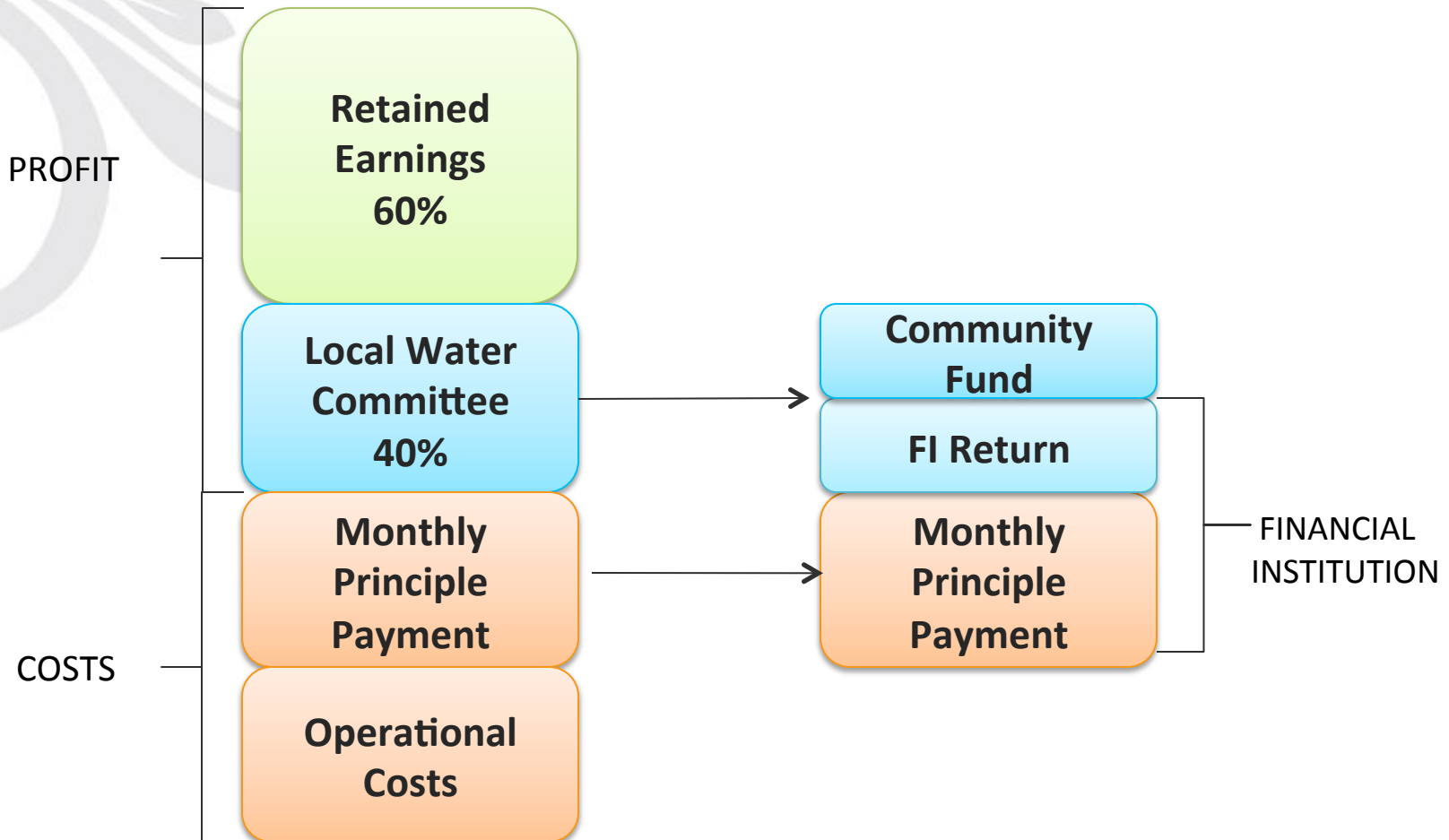
