




What is the problem?

- o Drive growth − 100 million people in 5 years



Measuring Success

Target Area Indicators

• Social capital Increase number of girls enrolling and staying in school Reduced girl/child dropout due to water access difficulty

• Health Reduce overall health care cost due to water-borne disease in affected places

• Productivity

Large reduction in girl/child water waiting time

(Reduced walking distance to get to water sources)

Reduction in the amount of time waiting


• Mortality Decrease in water-related mortality
